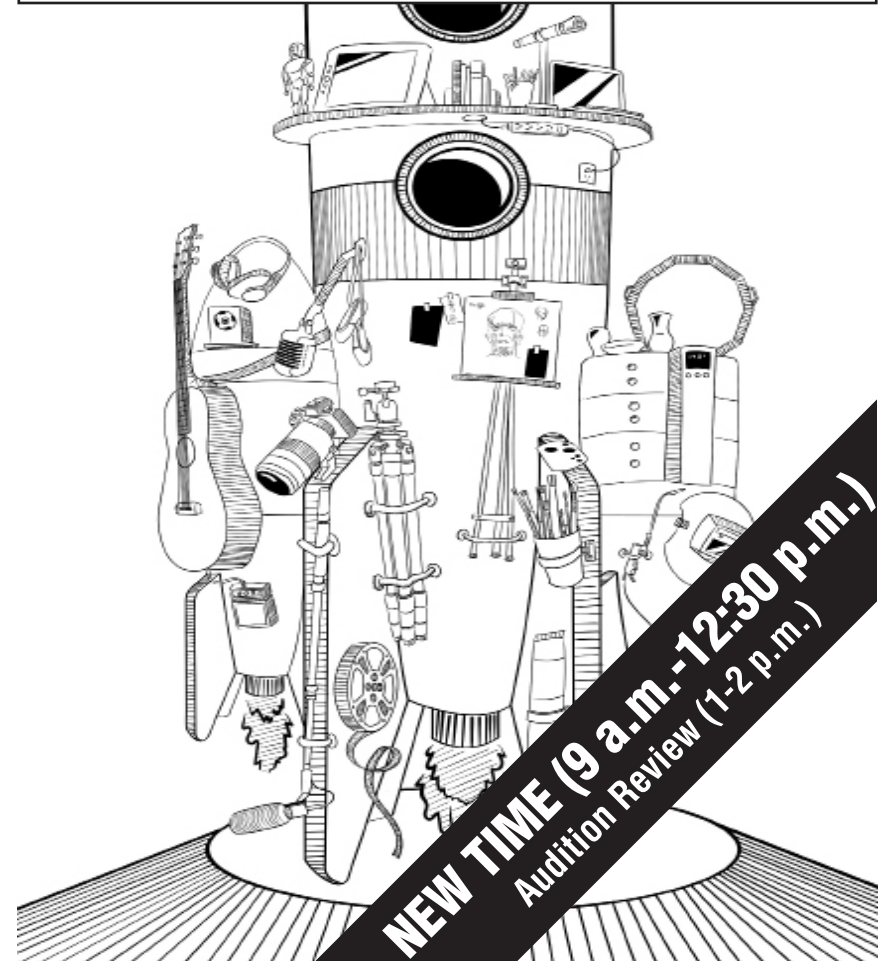

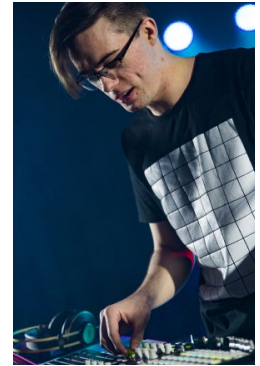

STUDENT WORKSHOP:

Students will work in state-of-the-art recording studios and experience the Studio Production Experience by writing, recording and mixing a song, and our Audio Post Production Experience where students will record dialogue, create sound FX, and other foley sounds for film/TV/video games. Participants will learn about basic recording techniques, music production, and post-production tools using Avid's Pro Tools and Logic Pro X recording software. All students will get hands- on experience with our Neve 5088 recording console and Avid S6 digital console. Students are welcome to bring their original song ideas, lyrics and instruments with them. A selection of drums, guitars, amplifiers and keyboards will be available. Multiple studios and edit/mix suites will also be open during the workshop.

TEACHER WORKSHOP (6 PGP POINTS):

Instructor: Miles Fulwider, Music Technology Program Director

High school music educators are invited to learn about how to integrate music technology into their own classes and curriculum. Participants help to guide the workshop as we cover a wide range of topics and answer questions. Some of the topics and questions in the past have included audio workstations (DAWs), recording choirs and ensembles, Pro Tools software, PBL techniques for music technology and music apps for tablets. Indiana Professional Growth Points and continuing education credit available to attendees. Multiple studios and edit/mix suites are available to provide access to educators during the workshop.
