### **CURRICULUM OVERVIEW** (8-Week Program)

- **WEEK 1-2: Drawing:** Master various drawing techniques, including graphite, charcoal, and pen and ink. Develop your observational skills and learn to capture the essence of subjects through drawing. Experiment with different styles and perspectives.
- WEEK 3-4: Painting: Explore different painting techniques and mediums, such as acrylics, watercolors, and mixed media. Learn about color theory, composition, and brushwork to create your own unique painting masterpiece.
- WEEK 5-6: Printmaking: Discover the art of printmaking through techniques like linocut and monoprint. Create multiple copies of your original artwork and explore the possibilities of printmaking as a medium.
- WEEK 7-8: Sculpture: Explore the world of three-dimensional art through sculpture. Work with a variety of materials, such as clay, paper, and found objects. Develop your spatial thinking skills and create unique sculptural forms.
